\$5000 Southwest Specialty Contractors Award (Juniors or Seniors)

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- * Seeking **graduating seniors and current sophomores and juniors** that are participants with NVCCF with a record of volunteerism in the community and with participation in NVCCF programs as well as in non-school sponsored activities and participation in extracurricular school activities. Applicants must be actively involved in NVCCF and receiving treatment or have had treatment within the last three years.
- * Scholarship funds will be paid **directly to the college or trade school** and not to the student. It will be the student's responsibility to submit to the Foundation at that time an invoice for tuition and fees, student ID number and college information. A letter of acceptance from the college or trade school of choice will also need to be provided.
- * Application must be submitted and received before **Aug 1, 2021, by 4:00 p.m.** to be considered. Late applications will **not be accepted**.
